SOCIAL BEHAVIOR. Agonistic Behavior. A quick note: "agonistic behavior" refers to the complex of aggression, appeasement and avoidance behavior that occurs between members of the same species. Agonistic behavior is a much broader term than "aggression," which refers to behavior patterns which serve to intimidate or damage another (for more, see McFarland, 1982).
